



Greater Iowa Credit Union's Give Iowa Program

Any Greater Iowa Credit Union member is eligible to nominate a qualifying non-profit organization or charity to receive a \$250 donation from Greater Iowa. The organization that receives the \$250 donation will be chosen at random from all submissions and will be placed on the Give Iowa crowdfunding website for additional donation considerations. Greater Iowa will also match up to an additional \$250 in donations from crowdfunding. Crowdfunding donations are open to the public – membership at Greater Iowa is not required.

Official Rules

Program Period: Eligibility for organizations will reset at the beginning of each month during the active program period, and one recipient organization will be chosen at random during each of those months. Recipient organization may be selected up to twice annually.

How To Enter: Nominations for qualifying non-profit or charitable recipient organizations are accepted at www.giveiowa.org. No paper nominations will be accepted.

Eligibility: Give Iowa Program subject to all federal, state and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited or otherwise restricted by law. The recipient organization may be required to complete an affidavit of eligibility and liability release form. If required, documents must be returned within seven (7) business days of receipt or the selected organization will be disqualified and donation will be forfeited. Greater Iowa Credit Union will not be responsible for any undeliverable or returned documentation. No transfer or assignment of donation is permitted. By participating in this program, organizations accept and agree to be bound by these Official Rules and the decision of Greater Iowa Credit Union, which shall be final, binding and conclusive in all matters.

Eligible organizations must be charitable and/or non-profit organizations within the state of Iowa. The chosen organization will be required to provide tax status documentation before any donation payment is issued by Greater Iowa Credit Union. Greater Iowa Credit Union reserves right to decline donation to any organization that does not qualify for charitable or non-profit status or it deems to be in direct conflict with, or damaging to, its brand and membership values including those judged solely upon any interpretation of turpitude.

Drawings: Random drawings will be conducted monthly from among all eligible entries received. Entries will not be carried over month-to-month during the program period. Random drawings will be conducted by Greater Iowa Credit Union's marketing department a week after the period date has ended.

Odds: Actual odds of an organization being selected to receive the donation and crowdfunding opportunity for any one (1) \$250 donation will depend on the number of eligible organization entries received for any one program period month.

Donations: One (1) organization will be selected per program period. The selected organization for each drawing will be contacted and arrangements for deposit of donations will be coordinated at that time. Give Iowa is solely sponsored by Greater Iowa with full donated funds going to the selected recipient organization. The first \$250, along with matching up to an additional \$250 of donation funds are the only portion of total funds recognized as originating from Greater Iowa Credit Union with the rest coming from the community at-large via the

crowdfunding initiative at www.giveiowa.org. Any information shared on www.giveiowa.org for at-large donation purposes- including name and email- will not be shared, offered, or sold to third parties.

Donation Restrictions: Donations are not transferable. No substitution of donation permitted except at the sole discretion of Greater Iowa Credit Union. Federal, state and local taxes on prize and any expenses relating to the acceptance of a prize are the responsibility of the selected organization. Limit two donations per organization per calendar year.

Awarding of Donations: Within 30 days of the closed Program Period, the organization will receive the \$250 donation from Greater Iowa Credit Union, any crowdfunding donations raised, and any matched funds in the form of one check. The selected organization will be notified by Greater Iowa Credit Union personnel to coordinate distribution. The organization may need to provide any and all necessary tax reporting information to claim the prize, including an IRS Form W-9 and an affidavit of eligibility and liability release and must provide a legal document showing Iowa residence or the prize will be forfeited. Selected organizations may receive an IRS Form 1099 for the value of the prize. In the event of noncompliance with these Official Rules, or if donation or donation notification is unclaimed or returned as undeliverable, the donation will be forfeited and may, at Greater Iowa Credit Union's discretion, be awarded to an alternate organization.

Additional Terms: By participating, recipient organization agrees to: (a) the Official Rules and the decisions of Greater Iowa Credit Union, which shall be final and binding in all respects; and (b) release, discharge and hold harmless Greater Iowa Credit Union from any liability, claims, or damages arising out of their participation in the sweepstakes and the acceptance, use, misuse, or possession of any prize. By accepting a donation, the organization agrees to, where legal, Greater Iowa Credit Union's use of the organization's name and/or likeness for advertising and publicity purposes in any and all media now or hereafter known throughout the world in perpetuity without compensation, permission, or notification and, upon request, will provide consent to such use in writing. As a condition of accepting a donation from Greater Iowa and participating in the Give Iowa program, the organization agrees that: (a) under no circumstances will participant be permitted to obtain awards for, and participant hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental, consequential, or any other damages, other than that for actual out-of-pocket expenses; (b) all causes of action arising out of or connected with this program, including any donation awarded, shall be resolved individual, without resort to any form of class action; and (c) any and all claims, judgments, and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, but in no event attorneys' fees. Greater Iowa Credit Union reserves the right to modify donation award procedures at its discretion. Greater Iowa Credit Union does not take responsibility for how the recipient organization(s) use donation funds or reporting of such fund usage.

Limitation of Liability: Greater Iowa Credit Union is not responsible for computer, printing, telephonic, typographical, human, or other errors, relating to or in connection with the Give Iowa program, including, without limitation, errors which may occur in the administration of the program, the announcement of the donations, the processing of the entries, or in any program-related materials; for late, inaccurate, misdirected, undelivered, incomplete, or illegible entries; or for transactions that are lost, misdirected, or fail to enter in the processing system; or are processes, reported, or transmitted late or incorrectly; or are lost for any reason, including computer, telephonic, paper-transfer, or human error, or electronic, computer or telephonic malfunction, damage, error omission, interruption, defect, delay in operating or transmission, or any combination thereof. Greater Iowa Credit Union reserves the right, at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual or organization it finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the program; to be acting in violation of the Official Rules; or to be acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten, or harass any other person or organization. Any use of robotic, automatic, programmed, or similar entry methods will void all

such entries by such methods. Greater Iowa Credit Union is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by the web-site users or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the program; operator errors; any error, omission, interruption, deletion, defect, delay in operation, or transmission, telephone or communications-line failure, theft or destruction; or any injury or damage to participants or to any other person's computer(s) related to or resulting from participating in this program. If, for any reason, the Give Iowa program is not capable of running as planned, or infection by computer viruses, bugs, or tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, actions of entrant, technical failures, or any other causes which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity, or proper conduct of the program, Greater Iowa Credit Union reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any entry or entrant and/or to cancel, terminate, modify, or suspend the program and at its sole discretion award a donation from among all eligible, non-suspect entries validly received prior to the action requiring such modification. By entering, all entrants agree that this program is governed by laws of the United States with venue in Ames, IA, for the resolution of all claims and disputes (excluding any claims against or dispute involving parties other than Greater Iowa Credit Union relating to any donation awarded in the sweepstakes). Greater Iowa Credit Union reserves the right to substitute actual donations with similar items of equal or greater value based upon item availability. Greater Iowa is not responsible for any tax deductibility or reporting. Please consult your tax advisor.
